Position Overview: Red Hare Brewing Company Assistant Taproom Manager is primarily responsible for assisting Taproom & Events Sr. Manager with taproom operations while providing excellent service to our customers.

Responsibilities:

- Assist Taproom & Events Sr. Manager with daily operations including opening and closing procedures
- Greet customers as they enter the brewery and invite them for tastings
- Provide customers with beer information, techniques, and history
- Inform customers on where to find Red Hare beers at retail, restaurants, and outside events
- Ensures cleanliness and sanitation of all equipment in the taproom
- Maintain a friendly, warm, and clean tasting room environment including any outdoor areas
- Help clean, organize, and re-stock tasting room
- Assist with end of the month inventory for taproom and merchandise store
- Participates in brewery functions and events
- Other duties as necessary
